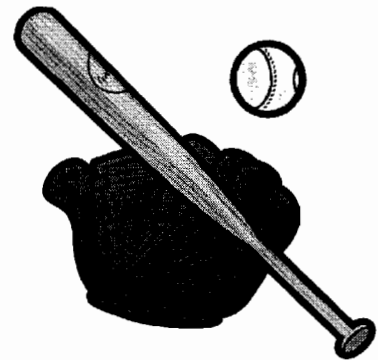
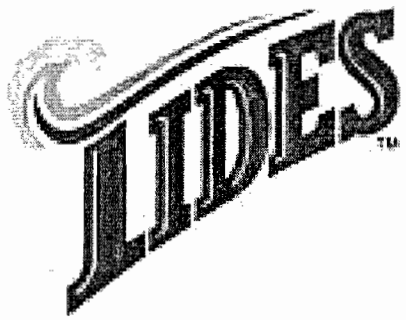

## How Much Should I Give Each Week?

The answer to that question must be carefully weighed by each individual and family. "I should give what my conscience tells me, what I have inwardly decided." (St. Paul). Whatever the amount is, *My gift should be measured by how I live and proportioned to my income.*

Some families may be able to increase 20%, 30% or maybe 50%, while others may only be able to increase 10% or 15%. Individuals and families have their own needs and their own ability to give. Please be as generous as possible. The chart that follows is to be used only as a guide.

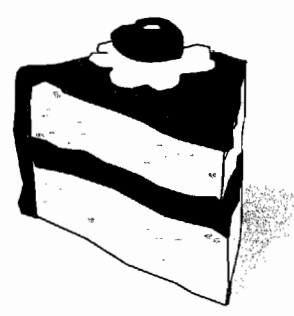
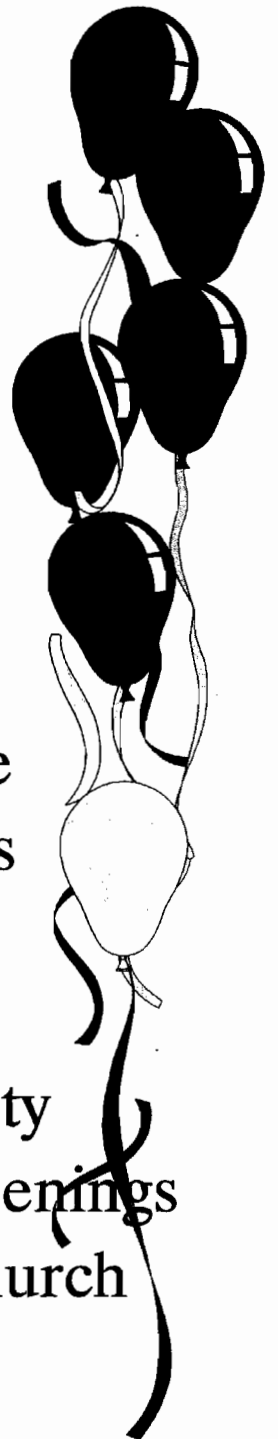

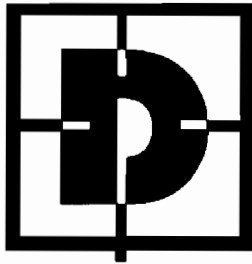
