**Migrant Ministry**

In late June and early July, thousands of migrant workers arrive on the Eastern Shore. They have come to work, picking the bounty from endless fields of tomatoes, beans, and other vegetables that have to be picked by hand. These migrant workers, most of whom are devout Catholics, seek dignity through work. Migrant workers are not traveling families, but men who will send home the money they make so their families will not live in abject poverty.

We as a church, a cluster of four churches, need to support our fellow man and recognize the human spirit and how our contributions can make a difference.

This is what they need:

New Toiletry Items

Food Lion Gift Cards - Jim Albright, the head of the Migrant Ministry for the Diocese, recommends \$10, \$15 or \$20 gift certificates to Food Lion so that they may purchase their own food. The gift cards are an important contribution because the Migrant Ministry office can offer immediate support when the workers first arrive. There will be a representative at each mass on collection weekends to collect these gift certificates. Last year, we collected over \$1600 in Food Lion cards.

The Migrant Ministry workers of the Eastern Shore were "overwhelmed" by this generosity. One of the first things they do is organize grocery-shopping trips with the new arrivals.

We will be collecting these items for the Migrant Ministry for two weekends.

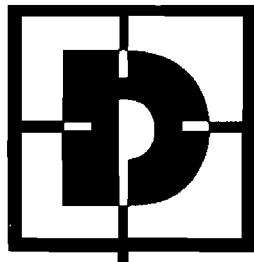
